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Opening Scenario:

28 y.o. female in car accident - 0 fractured R femur. Multiple deep lacerations R leg. G₁ P₀ 30 wks in normal pregnancy.
For ORIF - femur and debridement.

Major points of additional information to be provided to the candidate, e.g., hx, px, labs, x-ray, consults:

- No past medical/surgical hx.
 - Well assessed by competent trauma team: no other injuries. No LOC
- O/E in pain. BP 120/90 - HR 140 - Hb 70
- Assessment by obstetrician: fetal HR, ultrasound

Variable deceleration

AS Tenderness

U/S placenta
Abruptio**Major decision points (major decision points or options which must be recognized by the candidate)**

Volume status: blood loss with fracture, optimizing uterine blood flow.
Assessment and monitoring of uterine activity and fetus
Regional vs General.

Any followup information required to lead to the end of the question

Critical features to be included i.e. the *must* have to pass the question or to be considered *completely* unacceptable
***Must* assess fetus and realize potential for premature labor. *Must* choose anesthetic technique compatible with concerns re: fetus and premature labor.**
